

■ ■ ■ **CATEGORIES OF PERSONS EXEMPTED FROM VISA – REPUBLIC OF KENYA**

■ ■ ■ **Categories of persons who do NOT require visas**

- ■ Persons whose passport is endorsed with a valid Kenyan re-entry pass, or any other written authority in lieu of a re-entry pass.
- ■ Ship's passengers arriving and departing by the same ship, and who do not leave the ship.
- ■ Aircraft passengers transiting through Kenya, and who do not leave the international transit area of Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (Nairobi) or Moi International Airport (Mombasa).
- ■ Manifested crew of aircraft and ships passing through or stopping in Kenya, for periods not exceeding seven (7) days in the case of aircrew, and fourteen (14) days for ship's crew.
- ■ Owners of private aircraft stopping over for refuelling in Kenya, and who do not leave the precincts of the airport.
- ■ Holders of a laissez-passer issued by one of the organizations listed here below, while on official business for the organization in question, and upon presentation of an official document from this organization:
 - African Airlines Travel Association (IATA)
 - African Development Bank (ADB)
 - African Housing Fund (AHF)
 - African Reinsurance Corporation (ARC)
 - African Union (AU)
 - Arab Bank for Economic Development in Africa (ABEDA)
 - COMESA
 - Desert Locust Control Organization (DLCO)
 - Environment Liaison Centre International (ELCI)
 - European Union (EU)
 - Inter-Governmental Authority on Development (IGAD)
 - International Labour Organisation (ILO)
 - International Monetary Fund (IMF) and World Bank
 - International Potato Centre (CIP)
 - International Red Locust Control Organization for Central & Southern Africa (IRLCO)
 - Preferential Trade Area/Common Market of East & Southern Africa (PTA/COMESA)
